INSTRUCTIONS

1. All entries must be typed or printed and completely filled in. Incomplete entries will be returned.
2. Full name and USBC# must be shown (last name, first and middle initial).
3. When a bowler is listed on separate entries, both entries **MUST** be received together to assure they will be scheduled together. Crossed entries may not be scheduled at same date and time.
4. Make Checks or money orders payable to the Orlando Regional USBC and mail or deliver to our office at 10749 E. Colonial Drive, Orlando 32817-4439. **All monies MUST be received BEFORE March 7, 2018.**
5. Entries will close at midnight, March 3, 2018. All entries postmarked by March 5, 2018 will be accepted.
6. There will be a \$ 35.00 fee for any returned check.

TOURNAMENT RULES

1. This tournament is conducted for the members of the **Orlando Regional USBC and its members only**. Non-members may participate by having a USBC membership and paying the multi-membership fee of \$ 10.00 when the application is submitted to the tournament office.
2. **ENTERING AVERAGE:**
 - a) Entrants will use their highest USBC Yearbook average for the 2016-17 season, minimum of 21 games.
 - b) If no USBC 2016-17 Yearbook average, then the highest 21-game USBC average as of December 31, 2017 will be used
 - c) If neither is applicable, the highest 21-game 2017 USBC summer average will be used.
 - d) If current USBC average as of December 31, 2017 is more than ten (10) pins over the 2016-17 USBC average, then the December 31, 2017 USBC average will be used (minimum of 21 games)
 - e) If no 21-game USBC average in any individual league, then bowler will use composite average from all his/her leagues as long as the number of all games totals at least 21 games.
 - f) All others will bowl scratch.
 - g) **Bowlers must report their highest 2016-17 sport shot league average, if any. Then, that average will be computed according to chart in USBC Rule Book, and the adjusted average will be used if higher than 2016-17 season USBC average or December 31, 2017 average.**
3. It is each bowler's responsibility to verify the accuracy of his/her average, whether originally submitted by the bowler, the team captain, or others. Failure to use the correct average, or make a correction prior to the beginning of the second (2nd) game of the **FIRST** series shall disqualify score if submitted average is lower than actual average. Prize winnings will be based on submitted average if higher than the actual average. (Rule 319a, item 3)
4. Bowlers who have qualified for a prize of \$600 or more in any event of a tournament within the past twelve (12) months must report the actual score, position and amount won to the Tournament Director at the time of entry, in accordance with USBC Rule 319D. For this tournament, USBC Rule 319 a, b, c, d and e will apply. The Tournament Director may rerate the league average of entrant when there is evidence that his/her average does not represent their true ability
5. Handicap will be based on 90 percent of the difference between actual average and 240 scratch, computed on a three-game basis.
6. All prize money will be based on handicap scores, at a ratio of one for each eight entries (1:8) in each event except for all events will be one in ten (1:10) An Optional Scratch Division is available for additional fees.
7. In case of a tie for first place in any event, co-champions will be declared. In case of a tie for any position other than first place, prize moneys shall be divided equally among those tied for that position.
8. Substitutes, together with their team captain must present themselves to the Tournament Director **at least 45 minutes before scheduled squad bowling time**. Averages of substitutes must be verified by the team captain or no handicap will be allowed..
9. Changes are not permitted in the team or doubles line-up order.
10. Entrants may bowl only once in doubles and singles (bowlers must enter both double and singles events). Multiple participation is allowed in team event only. Must change a minimum of 2 bowlers in multiple team participation. The first team's scores will count for all events total.
11. **There shall be no more than two (2) PBA or PWBA members allowed on each team and only one (1) PBA or PWBA member per doubles team.**
12. Bowlers may not practice on the lanes, the day they are scheduled to bowl in the tournament.
13. Team captain is responsible for notifying all entrants of dates and times they are scheduled to bowl and must check in all team members at least thirty (30) minutes prior to squad time.
14. Errors in scoring must be reported, in writing, within 24 hours to the Tournament Director. Any protest or appeal affecting the playing rules or eligibility must be confirmed in writing to a tournament or local association official, or the United States Bowling Congress **BEFORE** the tournament prizes are awarded.
15. The Tournament Director shall have the right to refuse entry of any applicant into the tournament.
16. **DRESS CODE: THERE WILL BE NO TANK TOP SHIRTS OR SHORT SHORTS.**
17. USBC rules will apply in all cases not covered above.
