ORLANDO REGIONAL USBC 2019 WOMEN'S CHAMPIONSHIP TOURNAMENT RULES TOURNAMENT SITE: AMF ALTAMONTE LANES

TEAM / DOUBLES / SINGLES

- 1. The Annual Championship Tournament will be held MARCH 2-3, 2019.
- 2. It shall be a Handicap Tournament, one division, consisting of three events; **four** woman team, doubles and singles.
- 3. Entry fee shall be \$25.00 per event; **OPTIONAL:** All Events Handicap \$3.00; All Events Scratch \$5.00 (Bowlers may enter both optional all events)
- 4. After the entry has been received by the Association Manager, entry fee will not be refunded.
- 5. Individual handicap to be used; 90% of the difference between individual average and 220.
- 6. ENTERING AVERAGE:
 - a. Entrants shall use their highest 2017-18 certified USBC average (summer or winter) 21 games or more
 - b. If <u>no 2017-18 average</u>, entrant will use highest current average as of December 31, 2018, with 21 games or more
 - c. An entrant <u>without an average as shown above (a or b)</u> shall use her highest <u>current</u> 2018-19 USBC league average with at least 15 games as of February 15, 2019. Entrant must provide average verification.
 - d. If current USBC average as of December 31, 2018 is more than 10 pins over the 2017-18 USBC average, then the bowler must use her December 31, 2018 average (minimum of 21 games)
 - e. All others must use a scratch average of 220.
- 7. Entry deadline shall be February 15, 2019. All entries postmarked by February 19, 2019 will be accepted.
- 8. This is a right to membership tournament. You may enter the tournament if you have a current 2018-19 USBC membership.
- 9. A bowler may enter the team event more than once. Team must change at least (2) two bowlers in the lineup
- 10. List names on entry blank in order they are to bowl. No position changes will be allowed in the line-up after entry is accepted.
- 11. Scores from the first team event bowled shall be used toward your All Events Score.
- 12. A bowler who participates in doubles and singles must participate in both events and can only bowl <u>ONCE</u> in these events. Bowlers may bowl doubles and singles without bowling in the team event.
- 13. Plaques will be awarded to the 1st Pl Handicap Team, Handicap Doubles, Handicap Singles, Handicap All Events, and Scratch All Events. If there is a tie for First Place Co-champions will be declared. A monetary award will be given to the 1st place Scratch Winners of the Team, Doubles and Singles Events.
- 14. Team Captains shall check in at the Tournament Office 30 minutes prior to their scheduled time of bowling. All Substitutes will be placed in the spot in the line-up of the person she is replacing.
- 15. Doubles/Singles Events: A bowler shall bowl her doubles event first. If one bowler is late for the doubles event, the bowler present may bowl her singles event first. If her partner has not arrived by the time the singles event is completed and a substitute cannot be found, she will be permitted to bowl in the doubles event in order to qualify for the All Events.
- 16. There shall be no more that (2) PWBA members allowed on each team and only one (1) PWBA member per doubles event.
- 17. Entries will be scheduled in the order that they are received. A maximum of three sets of doubles will be scheduled to a pair of lanes. Adjustments to lane assignments will be made if necessary.
- 18. Doubles and Singles event will be bowled on the same lanes. Practice will be given for the Doubles Event only; Ten minutes of practice for the Team Event.
- 19. Lanes will be oiled before each squad.
- 20. At no time during tournament play shall anyone be allowed in the bowler's circle except participating bowlers and tournament officials.
- 21. There shall be no practice bowling on the assigned lanes the day of the tournament.
- 22. Any infraction of these rules will lead to possible bowler disqualification of any team or individual.
- 23. The President, with the approval of the Board of Directors of the Orlando Regional USBC, shall be empowered to relocate the Annual Championship Tournament to another center if, in their opinion, it becomes advisable as per USBC Rules.
- 24. There will be no pacers.
- 25. Rule 319 C will apply. Bowlers listed in a known or undeclared Sports League may have an average adjustment using the scale listed in the USBC playing rules. Tournament director has the right to re-rate any bowler with just cause.
- 26. Any rule not listed for this tournament will be enforced by USBC rules.
- 27. DRESS CODE: There will be NO tank top shirts or short shorts allowed.
