Tournament Rules

1. This tournament is USBC-certified and is open to all active, sanctioned USBC Youth members.
2. The tournament will consist of four divisions separated by average, as follows:

Div.	Entry Fee	Division Format (before stepladder finals)	House Average	Sport Average
A	\$ 80	Scratch – 3 blocks of 4 games each	186 & above	161 & above
B	\$ 80	Scratch – 3 blocks of 4 games each	150 - 185	135 - 160
C	\$ 80	Handicap – 3 blocks of 4 games each	110 - 149	110 - 134
D	\$ 50	Handicap – 3 blocks of 3 games each	Under 110	Under 110

3. **Bowlers must bring proof of current average (min. 12 games) to check-in.** A bowler's entering average is based on their highest 2021-2022 book average on bowl.com; however, if their current average is 10 or more pins higher than their 2021-2022 book average then they must use their current average for division placement ("10 pin rule"). If a bowler does not provide proof of their current average, they must bowl in Division A.
4. **Handicap** will be based on 90% of 200. All entering averages will be converted to Sport averages for all handicap calculations, including optional scholarship brackets.
5. **Entry Fees:** \$80 per bowler in divisions A, B, and C (\$36.00 lineage, \$10.00 expenses, \$34 FSYLEA Scholarship Fund); \$50 per bowler in division D (\$27.00 lineage, \$7.50 expenses, \$15.50 FSYLEA Scholarship Fund). Those paying by card will be charged an additional \$5.00 processing fee. Make all money orders or certified checks payable to FSUSBC. **NO PERSONAL CHECKS!!!** Those opting to move up from Division D must pay the higher entry fee amount. Tournament Directors will have the final discretion on any and all refunds. Bowlers are highly encouraged to submit their entries in advance (preferably with payment to speed up check-in).
6. **Tournament Check-in** will begin on Saturday, January 14th, 2023 at 8:00am and close at 9:45am. Walk-in entries are welcome as space permits. Entries are processed in the order received.
7. **Schedule:** Tournament consists of 3 separate blocks, followed by a stepladder finals, over 2 days.
Block #1 will begin on Saturday, January 14th, 2023 at 10:00am.
Block #2 will begin two (2) hours after Block #1 ends (approximately 3:00-3:30pm).
Block #3 will begin on Sunday, January 15th, 2023 at 9:00am.
The 5-person stepladder finals in each division begins once all scores are declared official.
NOTE: Check-in for blocks 2 & 3 will open up 1 hour before each block's starting time.
8. **Oil Patterns:** Each block will be bowled on a different sport-compliant pattern that is not disclosed until the entire event concludes.
9. **Junior Gold:** Qualifying will be in compliance with the USBC handbook. Jr. Gold qualifying will be 1:4 (no major fraction thereof). **Jr. Gold Qualifier Entry will be U18-\$50. U15-\$37.50 and U12-\$25. Qualifier entrants must have purchased a Gold membership prior to the start of competition.** Scratch scores from the first three (3) games of each block (9 games total) are used for Gold qualifying. Divisions may be combined if under 4 entrants in an age/gender division.

10. **Awards:** SMART scholarships will be awarded per division based on entries on a minimum 1:6 ratio. Additional scholarships may be awarded to the Highest Female Finisher (not cashing) and High Block per Block (not cashing). Scholarships will be awarded through SMART account # 10492.
11. **Dress Code:** Tournament management will determine proper attire. If deemed unacceptable, the participant will be required to change the attire immediately. If the participant is unable to change into proper attire, they will be removed from the competition that day and no refunds given. **Shirts:** Collared, V-neck, rib-lined or banded neckline. Mock collars must be a minimum of three-quarters of an inch. All shirts must have finished sleeves. Females may wear a sleeveless shirt with a butterfly collar only if the sleeves are finished. **Pants:** Male participants are required to wear slacks. Slacks must not contain drawstring waists or elastic bottoms and must have a zipper and a button to be eligible. **Jeans and yoga pants are not permitted.** Female participants are required to wear slacks, skirts, capris, skorts or walking shorts. All skirts, capris, skorts or walking shorts must be **below the competitor's fingertips** when they are standing with their arms hanging loosely at their side.
12. **Dry towels / pads only** may be placed on the score console or ball return. Rule 18 eliminates the use of any products on a bowling ball once competition has started; this includes powder, patting rosin bags on the ball and cleaners formerly listed as approved for competition. No powder or rosin bags allowed in the bowling circle. No modifications can be made to affect the balance or surface of the ball once competition has begun. Penalty: 1st offense, removal of ball from competition; 2nd offense, disqualification.
13. Bowlers will be disqualified for any of the following but are not limited to: A) Kicking and/or hitting any of the following ball returns, score consoles, walls, chairs and/or tables. B) Using profanity, obscene / immensely loud gestures (Tournament Director has final say in what is considered excessive gesturing) and excessive lofting.
14. Appeals or protest regarding scores or eligibility must be filed in accordance with USBC rule #329.
15. Scores will be recorded and initialed by another bowler on your lanes. All bowlers must have their score sheet signed. Each bowler is responsible for the verification of his/her own scores/division. All scores are unofficial until verification.
16. The Tournament Director's decisions will be final.
17. All pre-registered mail-in entries need to be postmarked by January 7th, 2023.
