Orlando Regional USBC Youth City Championships Rules

- **1. PARTICIPATION:** All participants must be members of USBC prior to entry. An athlete may enter in the team event more than once provided that a minimum of 2 athletes are replaced on any roster. The 1st team event bowled will count towards their all events total. An athlete may enter doubles and singles events only once unless utilized as a substitute. If you bowl doubles, you must bowl singles and vice-versa (exception to the Bumper Singles Division that only bowls singles). Three games will be bowled in each event. All athletes entered in Team, Doubles, and singles are automatically entered in All Events.
- 2. ATHLETE EXPECTATIONS: Athletes are required to check-in a minimum of 30 minutes prior to bowling in proper bowling attire. Refer to the USBC dress code below for proper attire. All athletes must be present at the start of game 1. Tardy athletes will receive zeros for any missed frames. Athletes should be ready to bowl when it is their turn. A Tournament Official must be notified if an athlete needs to leave the bowling area. A delay in game could result in the athlete receiving zeros for any frames missed.
- **3. DRESS CODE:** No halters, tank tops, or head apparel will be permitted. Shorts, skorts, or skirts must be longer than your fingertips when placed by your side. All pants will be worn at the waist level with no underwear or bare skin showing. Refer to the USBS dress code for proper attire.
- **4. TEAM EVENT:** Teams will be made up of any combination of 4 youth athletes. Team Event Divisions are average based and are as follows: (1) 700 & above, (2) 540-699, (3) 380-539, and (4) 189 & below.
- **5. DOUBLES EVENT:** Doubles will be made up of any combination of 2 youth athletes. Doubles Event Divisions are average based and are as follows: (1) 350 & above, (2) 270-349, (3) 190-269, and (4) 189 & below.
- **6. SINGLES EVENT:** Singles competition will offer 10 divisions based on gender, average and bumpers. Singles Event Divisions are as follows: (1) 175 & above, (2) 135-174, (3) 95-134, (4) 94 & below, and (B) Under 8 Bumpers (no average requirement).
- **7. ALL EVENTS:** All Events competition will offer 8 scratch & 8 Handicap divisions based on gender and average. Athletes must compete in each event once to be eligible, and their first scores will count towards their ALL Events total. All Events Divisions are as follows: (1) 175 & above, (2) 135-174, (3) 95-134, and (4) 9*4 & below.
- **8. HANDICAP:** Handicap will be based on 100% of 210. Team, Doubles, and Singles Events will be handicap except for the Bumpers Singles Division which will be scratch.
- **9. SUBSTITUTIONS & LINEUPS:** Team, Doubles, and Singles will bowl as per lineup on the final recap sheet. Substitutions will be permitted in any event. A substitute report form will be required for each event and must be turned into the tournament manager prior to bowling, signed by the Youth Director with all information confirmed. An athlete may earn scholarships more than once in the doubles events only if they entered the event as a substitute. A substitution may result in re-classification to different division. Substitutes must bowl in the order of the person they are replacing.
- 10. AVERAGES: Athletes will use first qualifying average from the following list:
 - **a.** Highest Current Average as of January 1, 2024 (minimum of 6 games)
 - b. Highest 2022-2023 certified final average (Winter or Summer Season) minimum of 12 games
 - **c.** Athletes with none of the above averages must bowl scratch.
- **11. SPORT OR CHALLENGE AVERAGES:** All Challenge and Sport Leagues must be reported, and the tournament director will adjust these averages according to USBC guidelines. The tournament director will verify all averages and youth directors must review entry confirmations. Contact the tournament office if there are any questions. These charts can be found on BOWL.com The athlete is required to convert their average bowled on sport or challenge conditions to a standard condition utilizing these charts. If a athlete has averages in both sport and challenge conditions, all averages must be converted to an equivalent standard average. Once all averages have been converted, the athlete will use highest average of the converted averages to enter the competition.
- **12. SCHOLARSHIPS & AWARDS:** All awards will be given to one out of six (1:6) entries. In case of a tie duplicate awards will be given in accordance with USBC guidelines. Scholarship awards will be presented at the ORUSBC Awards Ceremony.
- **13. REGISTER:** Entries are due on January 6, 2024. No entries will be accepted without fees. All entries must be complete. Tournament entries will be processed in the order they are received. No refunds will be given after processing. There are no guarantees that all teams form a center will be scheduled on the same squad. Payment can be made with a Bowling Center Check, Money Order, or Cash. Credit Cards are not accepted. All Checks should be made payable to Orlando Regional USBC. Entries should be mailed to: Orlando Regional USBC, 10749 E. Colonial Dr., Orlando, FL 32817. Youth Directors are responsible for reviewing entries upon receipt of confirmations.
- **14. OFFICIALS & RVPs:** Coaching will be allowed outside of the bowling circle. Only participating Athletes, Tournament Staff, Registered Volunteers (wearing RVP credentials), Youth Directors, and Bowling Center Personnel are allowed in the bowling circle
- **15. TOURNAMENT GUIDELINES:** Scores will be written neatly and correctly on score sheets. Scores are unofficial until verified by the Tournament Staff. Athletes are responsible for their own scores. Any appeals or protests regarding scores or eligibility will be reported to the Tournament Director immediately. The Tournament Director should be made immediately aware of any problems with automatic scoring or lane issues. This is a USBC certified tournament and all rules will be in compliance with USBC Guidelines.
