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Orlando Regional Open Championships Instructions:

- 1. All entries must be typed or printed and filled in. Incomplete entries will be returned.
- 2. Full name and USBC# must be shown (last name, first and middle).
- 3. When a bowler is listed on separate entries, both entries MUST be received together to assure they will be scheduled together.
- 4. Make Checks or money orders payable to Orlando Regional USBC and mail or deliver to our office at 10749 E. Colonial Dr., Orlando, FL 32817-4439. Forms of payments accepted are money order, cashier's check, or personal check. Credit Cards (Visa & MasterCard only) will be accepted with \$25 processing fee per team please call Tournament Office to pay by credit card.
- 5. Entries will close at midnight on March 28, 2026. All entries and fees MUST be received by this date. There will be a \$35 fee for any returned check.

Tournament Rules:

1. This is a right to membership tournament. You may enter the tournament if you are not a member of the Orlando Regional USBC, by having a current 2025-2026 USBC membership (no transfer fee will apply).

2. ENTERING AVERAGE:

- a. Entrants will use their highest USBC certified average for the 2024-2025 winter season average of 21 games or more.
- b. If no USBC 2024-2025 winter average, then the highest 2025 summer average of 21 games or more.
- c. If entrant does not have 21 games in any individual league, then bowler will use a composite average from all their 2024-2025 leagues if the number of all game's totals at least 21 games.
- d. 10-pin rule is in effect, if your current USBC certified average is more than 10 pins (minimum 21 games) over certified average at the time of bowling your current average must be reported to the tournament director to be adjusted, if not reported your scores will be subject to forfeiture.
- e. All others will bowl with a 240 average. If a bowler does not have a standard average and ONLY has a sport or challenge shot average, his sport/challenge shot average will be converted as per the USBC conversion chart, and that computed average will be used.
- 3. For this tournament, USBC Rule 319 D will be waived.
- 4. The Tournament Director may rerate the league average of entrant when there is evidence that his/her average does not represent their true ability.
- 5. Handicap will be based on 90% of the difference between actual average and 240 scratch.
- 6. All prize money will be based on handicap scores, at a ratio of one for each eight entries (1:8). In each event except for all events which will be one in ten (1:10). An Optional Scratch Division is available for additional fees and all monies will be distributed accordingly. Each participant must be in Handicap events to participate in scratch events.
- 7. In case of a tie for first place in any event, co-champions will be declared. In case of a tie for any position other than first place, prize money shall be divided equally among those for that position.
- 8. Substitutes, together with their team captain must present themselves to the Tournament Director at least 30 minutes before scheduled squad bowling time. Averages of substitutes must be verified as per the average rule.
- 9. Changes are not permitted in the team or doubles line-up order.
- 10. Entrants may bowl only once in doubles and singles (bowlers must enter both doubles and singles events). **Multiple** participation is allowed in Team Event only. Team must change of minimum of 2 bowlers in multiple team participation. The first team's scores will count for all events totals.
- 11. There shall be no more than two (2) PBA or PWBA members allowed on each team and only one (1) PBA or PWBA member per doubles event.
- 12. Bowlers may not participate on the lanes, the day they are scheduled to bowl in the tournament.
- 13. Team Captain is responsible for notifying all entrants of dates and times they are scheduled to bowl and must check in all team members at least 30 minutes (30) prior to squad time.
- 14. Errors in scoring must be reported, in writing, within 24 hours to the Tournament Director. Any protest or appeal affecting the playing rules or eligibility must be confirmed in writing to a tournament or local association official, or the United States Bowling Congress BEFORE the tournament prizes are awarded.
- 15. The Tournament Director shall have the right to refuse entry from any applicant into the tournament.
- 16. DRESS CODE: Appropriate attire is required. THERE WILL BE NO TANK TOPS SHIRTS or SHORT SHORTS.
- 17. USBC rules will apply in all cases not covered above.
